- Partnering with local police on child ID kits.
- Partnering with firefighters on fire safety and prevention.
- Partnering with EMTs to host CPR training.
- Partnering with parks and recreation department to plant trees, adopt-a-park initiatives and develop community art installations.
- Partnering with an animal shelter or mobile neutering clinic.
- Partnering with a soup kitchen to stock shelves to serve food.

When working with these organizations for the Auxiliary Outreach program be sure that the member(s) volunteering is *wearing* a VFW Auxiliary item. It can be a shirt, hat, jacket or name tag. Smile and be proud to wear them with pride, we may never know who we will run into. Also take *pictures* of your events as I would love to share them on our Facebook page and remember the National Award wants a photo collage of all your great community events throughout the 24-25 year. Finally, it is considered Auxiliary Outreach if the project was *approved* by the Auxiliary and must be *recorded* in the meeting minutes prior to the project. On rare occasions such as a natural Disaster or emergency community need, the project may be voted on after the fact. All it takes is one Auxiliary member volunteering to count. When reporting please report the number of members, hours and miles used to assist the event. Please include in the report that the event was voted, approved and documented in meeting minutes.
