<u>Chief of Staff (Extension and Revitalization)</u> Healthy Auxiliary Due Dates/Reminders

If you have not done so, **Department is requesting that Reports of Installation be entered into MALTA by June 15 and copies sent to Department and your District President.** In addition, Department will need a copy of your appointed chairmen.

The President at all levels is reminded to submit to their respective Commanders, within thirty (30) days after installation into office, the last quarterly audit and membership status report.

Bonds will not be available to purchase in MALTA until after July 1 and purchased by August

31. The cost of the bond and the amount covered by the bond must be approved by the body and entered in the Secretary's minutes. Bonds are to be completed by August 31, or the Auxiliary will be subjected to a Suspension.

The second quarterly audit report for April, May, June, is to be completed by July 31, approved by the Auxiliary vote, and submitted to Department by August 31.

What is a Mentor? A Mentor is ALL of us. In some shape or fashion, we are all Mentors to each other. Some have excellent knowledge of the Bylaws, some have knowledge of the National and Department Programs, and some are experienced in the overall workings of the Auxiliary all the way from the local level to the National level.
