District Presidents: At your next District meeting, invite your members to contact the Unaffiliated Posts in your District. Please make sure that only <u>one</u> contact is made per post. By doing this the membership in your District will grow. Once a Commander of an Unaffiliated Post says that he/she would welcome us coming to a meeting the following are the tools that the presenter should take or do:

- ✓ Our National Website (under Chief of Staff resources) has the Presentation to Bachelor Post using two different methods
- ✓ Take the Eligibility Wheel, with enough copies to give to each Post member
- ✓ Take copies of the National Facts leaflet (you can get these from National for free)
- ✓ Take copies of the Application form
- ✓ The presenter should let Post members know about the procedures to start an Auxiliary located in our Bylaws, Article II Section 202. A list may be helpful for the Commander.

If the VFW is interested, please let me know and I will assist in any way that I can to help them get started.

Auxiliary Presidents: Now is a great time to check on the Membership Committee that you appointed in the beginning of the year! How is membership going so far this year? Has the Committee contacted all unpaid annual members? Are there members who are in need of the Auxiliary to pay their dues out of the relief fund?

Good Job Awards: Do you have those few people who are always doing something extra for the Auxiliary? Maybe they are an officer who consistently does a great job in their position. Maybe it is a Chairman who just put on a great program for our veterans or a fundraiser for your Auxiliary. Maybe it is a member who assisted a Chairman? Whatever the case, how about giving

 30.
- ✓ Report in all programs
- ✓ Dues submitted to National via MALTA or to Department

R U Healthy Checklist reminders for November:

- ✓ IRS Form 990 ePostcard filed by November 15
- ✓ Trustees should have already completed the July, August, September audit. Have it approved at your November meeting, and mail it to Department by November 30.
- ✓ Additional dues notices sent, and dues submitted through the MALTA system or to Department
- ✓ Purchase 2026 Bylaws and Ritual from the VFW Store
- ✓ Report in all programs
