This year, our program will focus on these core areas:

1. VFW-Based Veterans Assistance Programs

The VFW provides a wide range of services to assist veterans, their families, and service members with VA claims and benefits.

At the heart of these efforts are VFW Service Officers—trained professionals who help veterans navigate the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) system to secure the benefits they have earned. Their services include:

- Case preparation
- Claims and appeals assistance
- Transition support for separating service members
- Advocacy at every step of the process
- Financial Assistance for Service Members

The VFW Financial Assistance Program supports active-duty service members (including activated Guard/Reserve) and their families who face financial hardships due to deployment, military-related injury, or other unexpected challenges.

- 5 Up to \$2,500 in grants not loans (no repayment required)
- Direct payments to creditors
- Covers essentials like housing, utilities, medical bills, and food

2. Support for Student Veterans

The VFW offers dedicated support for student veterans through the following programs:

- Sport Clips Help A Hero Scholarship

3. Veterans' Mental Health Matters

Mental health is a critical part of every veteran's well-being—and our program recognizes this as a key pillar.

4. Veteran and Spouse Employment Support

Employment is essential—not only for financial stability but also for a veteran's sense of purpose and belonging. This also extends to their spouses, many of whom must reenter the workforce after years of supporting their partner's service.
