How You Can Help:

- Assemble blessing bags filled with essentials such as socks, hats, gloves, toothbrushes/paste, soap, and other personal care items.
 These small gestures offer warmth, dignity, and hope—demonstrating that our Veterans are not forgotten.
- Host a blanket drive to provide warmth during the coldest time of year.
 A warm blanket not only protects against harsh weather, but also reminds our Veterans that they are seen, valued, and appreciated.
- If you are in a highly populated area, open your doors on especially cold days.
 Create a simple warming station offering soups, coffee, hot cocoa, and blankets.
 Partner with your community for donations and support—many hands make light work.

Start a New Tradition:

As a new year approaches, consider launching **at least one new event** that connects your post home with your community. The more frequently we welcome others into our space, the more likely we are to connect with a Veteran or family of a Veteran in need.
