Mentoring: Our National Extension & Revitalization Ambassador, Karlene Beams, has a powerful theme this year: "You can't stop the waves, but you can learn to surf." Thinking about this, I realize that while Michigan doesn't have many surfing spots on the Great Lakes, the thrill of riding those waves is something you can experience in many ways—not just on the water. That same adrenaline rush can come from mentoring others

and sharing our organization's mission. So, take a moment to guide new members, help them find their footing, and let them feel that same exciting energy that comes from making a difference.

Performance Improvement Plans: There's a new approach for Auxiliaries that are having trouble. Instead of suspending them, the Department will now send a Performance Improvement Plan (PIP) committee to meet with the officers and any members involved. Together, they'll work on identifying issues and building a Performance Improvement Plan. With support from the committee, the Auxiliary takes ownership of the plan and gets actively involved, rather than being sidelined. The committee will guide the process and gradually help the Auxiliary get back on track, attending meetings as needed and helping resolve problems before suspension even becomes an option.



**New Auxiliaries:** Michigan is doing great in starting new Auxiliaries this year as we already have four new ones, however, there is still much to do. There are many unaffiliated VFW posts in the great state of Michigan. Here is a list of the initial steps for creating an Auxiliary:

- 1. A VFW Post must have a 2/3 vote of the Post membership present to have an Auxiliary. Written communication of the proposed formation of an Auxiliary must be given to the entire membership of the Post at least 20 days prior to the meeting.
- 2. The Department President appoints the official organizer of that Auxiliary and at least two others who will assist in mentoring the new Auxiliary.
- 3. A minimum of 15 eligible applicants must be on the Charter application. Transfers are accepted at the closure of the institution and just prior to the installation of the newlyformed Auxiliary.
