The VFW Auxiliary is pleased to present a National Scholarship to assist VFW Auxiliary members and their families who wish to further their education by pursuing a college degree or a career direction at a vocational/technical school. Each year, one (1) recipient will be selected from each of the four (4) VFW Auxiliary Conferences and will be awarded a \$1,250 scholarship to be used within the academic year following completion of the contest. The scholarship will be paid directly to the American college/university or vocational/technical school of the awardee's choice upon the completion of the scholarship activation requirements. Eligibility: • VFW Auxiliary member for at least one full year by the application submission deadline of February 15. • The spouse, son and/or daughter of a VFW Auxiliary member that has been a member at least one full year by the application submission deadline of February 15. • Applicants must be 21 years of age or older by the application submission deadline of February 15. • Previous National Continuing Education Scholarship winners are not eligible. The National President's special project this year is the Continuing Education Scholarship. Your Auxiliary can send checks to National headquarters earmarked National President's special project or make donations through Malta.
