- Blue star families can display a flag or banner with a white field and a red border, with a blue star for each family member serving in the US armed forced during any period of war or hostilities.
- Gold star families can display a flag or banner with a white field and a red border, with a gold star that represents a family member who died during military operations.
- Silver star families can display a flag a banner with a blue field, and outer red and inner white border, with a silver star that represents a family member who was injured, wounded, or became ill during or as a result of combat.
