Resolutions Passed on the National convention business floor by registered delegates.

Resolution # 1 Sec. 806D—Department Installation

All officers except for the Treasurer and Secretary shall enter upon the duties of their respective offices at the
conclusion of the current Auxiliary year. The treasurer and Secretary shall enter upon the duties of their
respective offices at the conclusion of the current Auxiliary fiscal year.

Resolution #2A Sec. 708—National Dues

• National dues shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) per annum for each member, effective July 1, 2024, paid by ACH transaction to National Headquarters.

Resolution #3 Sec. 102--Application

• The Department Treasurer shall transmit to the National Treasurer fifteen dollars (\$15.00) of the dues collected for each Member At Large Beginning on July 1, 2024.

A Special Council of Administration Meeting was called to order at the 2023 National Convention to address the appeal of Carrie turner as National District Council Member Area B representing Michigan, being removed from office by then National President Jane Reape. The Council of Administration voted to uphold the decision of the National President. Stephanie Krueger was elected at our June 2023 Convention to fill the position and will serve until June 2024.
