The Department is mailing each Auxiliary a packet containing necessary information and Delegate Forms.

Sec. 301-Eligibility

A. Any member in good standing in their respective Auxiliary shall be eligible for election as a District, Department or National Delegate.

Sec. 302-District Meetings and Convention

- A. Delegates and Alternates to Districts shall be elected at a regular meeting of the Auxiliary held not less than 10 (10) calendar days prior to the District Convention at which District Officer's are to be elected.
 - 1. One (1) Delegate and one (1) Alternate foreach fifteen (15) members or fraction thereof in good standing in the Auxiliary at the time of the election of Delegates.

Sec. 303-Department Meetings and Convention

- A. Delegates and Alternates to Departments shall be elected at a regular meeting of the Auxiliary held not less than thirty (30) calendar days prior to the Department Convention:
 - One (1) Delegate and one (1) Alternate for each thirty (30) members or fraction thereof in good standing in the Auxiliary at the time of the election of the Delegates.

Sec. 304-National Convention

- A. Delegates and Alternates to the National Convention shall be elected at the last regular meeting in April.
 - 1. One (1) Delegate and one (1) Alternate for each fifty (50) members or fraction thereof in good standing in the Auxiliary on March 31.

Please return the Reports of Installation to the Department Office no more than sisty (60) calendar days prior to the convening of the Department Convention.

We have a patriotic holiday we can promote this month, it is National Vietnam War Veterans Day, March 29th, which honors those who served during the longest conflict in US History. There were 8.7 million Vietnam Era Veterans, with 3.4 million deployed downrange. This holiday was introduced in 2017 to honor these veterans on the day of the anniversary of the withdrawal of military units from South Vietnam by US Senators Pat Toomey, and Joe Donnelly. President Trump signed the act on March 28, 2017, calling for US flags to be flown on March 29th for those who served.





Review of the Healthy Auxiliary checklist found on the Chief of Staff Program page:

Next month (APRIL) is Auxiliary Elections.

If you have issues please call me immediately so we can assist you.

- District Delegates are often elected in March to allow time to comply with the By-Laws timing in relation to your District Meeting. Auxiliary nominations and elections are done in the same month, April along with Department Delegates. National Delegates can occur then also.
- We have completed the round of February District meetings and many auxiliaries apparently do not realize that they are violating the By-Laws when NO ONE from the auxiliary attends the regularly scheduled District meeting. Make a plan now to get someone there to represent your Auxiliary when the April and May Convention meetings occur. HEALTHY Auxiliaries have representation at EVERY District meeting, as the By-Laws require.
- The October, November, December audit was to be completed January 31, 2024 and approved by your Auxiliary at a meeting, and in the Department Office by February 29, 2024. If not done, you must contact the Department President.

Now that we are well on our way to meeting the required Healthy Auxiliary Criteria, please remember that assistance is just a call away - please don't be afraid to ask.

There are many opportunities out there to assist in getting new auxiliaries, and in fact several teams are working with Posts on this. Let us know if you know of one we can help start the process.

As we continue working this Spring on the second half of this administrative year, I remind all to keep working together as a team.

April 2024 Bulletin Extension and Revitalization

Here we are! April – the month of annual Auxiliary election of officers.

By now you should have received paperwork for election of District, Department and National Delegates. So here is a quick review of requirements for each of them. (Sections 301-308 of National By-Laws)

- District Delegates and Alternates One Delegate and One Alternate for every 15 members (at the time of election) and fraction over = One more of each. These are elected at a regular Auxiliary meeting held NO LESS THAN 10 calendar days prior to the District Convention where officers of the District are elected. A copy is sent ASAP to the District Secretary.
- Department Delegates and Alternates One Delegate and One Alternate for every 30 members (at the time of election) and a fraction over = One more of each. These are elected at a regular Auxiliary meeting held NO LESS THAN 30 calendar days prior to convening of the Department Convention where officers of the Department are elected. A copy is sent ASAP to the Department Secretary. NOTE that this year we start the convention on May 30th so these must be elected at your April meeting. Paperwork was sent to you for this telling the fees required to accompany the list. Whether your Auxiliary attends or not the fee is Mandatory. If you do not send in the money required, a bill will be sent to your Auxiliary.
- National Delegates and Alternates One Delegate and One Alternate for every 50 members and fraction over = One more Delegate and One more Alternate (number is based on your March 31st membership). The Auxiliary secretary is to provide this list to the National secretary along with their member number no less than 30 days after election is held. Your Auxiliary Secretary can enter into Malta or mail it to the National Secretary. Allow time for the mail to get it there on time.

Election of officers is held in April and nominations and elections are done at the April meeting ONLY. (See Section 804 ELECTIONS in the National By-Laws, as well as pages 8-11 in the Booklet of Instructions). This is a perfect guide to run a smooth election. Paperwork should be sent to the Department Office and your District as soon as possible. Rosters cannot be completed on either level without this getting sent in a timely manner.

Do all you can to be a Healthy Auxiliary and avoid those Red Flags!



There are less than 8 weeks left for doing, acting, and reporting. So let us go through this again. Legislative work is about making friends and influencing others.

- 1. Did you or your members write to Senators Peters and Stabenow?
- 2. Did you or your members write to your representatives in DC?
- 3. Did you or your members write to your state representatives in Lansing?
- 4. Did you report the total number of members who receive Action Corps weekly reports?
- 5. Did you invite state representatives to a program at your post? Did you report in detail who, what, when?
- 6. Did you attend an event where politicians were present and talk with them about veterans issues? Did you report in detail who, what, when?
- 7. Did you print from the national Malta website priority goals and distribute materials to friends, members, the community? Did you report in detail who, what, when?
- 8. Did you participate in the department initiative to have petitions signed for a veteran cemetery in the Upper Peninsula?

We are influencing Lansing to be serious about this initiative. Governor Whittmer appointed State Representative Jenn Hill to investigate a location in the upper peninsula. Now we need to push even harder. Keep sending me the completed petition pages.

The area that the Commander's Group has their eye on is KI Sawyer Air Base that was closed in 1995. The airfield at one time was a small airport that was under Marquette county jurisdiction. With World War II, the federal government negotiated a deal to lease the airport and develop the small airfield into a larger field to handle military aircraftl. Since the closing, the federal government should allow control to revert back to Marquette and Marquette should allow the development of a veteran cemetery.

I am asking all concerned individuals to write to Representative Jenn Hill and ask why we cannot petition the federal government to re-designate KI Sawyer Air Base for the purpose of a veterans' cemetery in the upper peninsula. While you are writing to Representative Hill, also include Representative Greg Markkanen; Representative Dave Prestin and State Senator Edward McBroom. This is not just a VFW concern, but one for all veterans in Michigan. Ask your family, friends, neighbors, American Legion, DAV, VietNam Veterans, AmVets, etc., to write/contact these individuals for a repurpose of the land at KI Sawyer to become a veterans' cemetery.


