Entry form required and available on MALTA Member Resources. VFW Auxiliaries must send the required entry form to their Department Legislative Chairman by March 31, 2025 for judging. Citations will be mailed directly to the winning VFW Auxiliaries from National Headquarters and money will be deposited into the winning VFW Auxiliary account after the 2025 VFW Auxiliary National Convention.

DEPARTMENT AWARDS FOR AUXILIARIES

- Best outstanding activity and/or event collaborating with the VFW Post connecting members with local lawmakers in each membership category. Must send required National entry form to Department chairman. \$10 and Citation of Merit to the Auxiliary
- Best Legislative Program. \$10 and Citation of Merit to the Auxiliary
- Best Overall Promotion of VFW Priority Goals and VFW Action Corps Weekly. \$10 and Citation of Merit to the Auxiliary
- Best Overall Promotion of Contacting your Legislators regarding Veteran issues. \$10 and Citation of Merit to the Auxiliary
