### PROGRAM GOALS Building Partnerships – Auxiliary Participating in Outreach

Auxiliary Outreach is members partnering with organizations for the benefit of your local community or institutions. The Outreach can be performed by people of any age, skills set or ability. The project can benefit any group of people such as children, senior citizens, persons with disabilities, and for the public. An Outreach can be held in communities of all types and sizes – rural, suburban and urban, small and large. Some ideas to be considered for Auxiliary Outreach are as follows:

- Participation in walks/runs that benefit other organizations.
- Partnering with local Police, Firefighter, EMT's to assist with their community training programs.
- Partnering with parks and recreations to departments to assist with their developments.
- Partnering with an animal shelter and assist with their community programs.
- Partner with a soup kitchen and assist with their community programs.

There are so many ways to reach out to your community. Just google "community events" in your local area and see what pops up like a Shelter house, Hospice Home or Homeless shelter looking for volunteers. Once the Auxiliary is ready to assist with a project, be proud and visible; show your pride by wearing Auxiliary-branded attire. Remember this is for the organization and shows our community participation and not just in our Post homes.

Finally, it is considered Auxiliary Outreach if the project was approved by the Auxiliary and recorded in the meeting minutes prior to the project. On rare occasions such as a natural disaster or emergency community need, the project may be voted on after the fact. All it takes is one Auxiliary member volunteering to count.

### National Bylaws/Administrative Responsibilities (all MUST be done on time to achieve a total of 100 points)

- 1. District Report of Installation MUST be received at National Headquarters by 6/30/24.
- Reports of Installation from all your Auxiliaries MUST be received at National Headquarters by 6/30/24, with a copy to the Department Secretary, or a request for a suspension by the Department President will be submitted to National.
- 3. District and all Auxiliaries MUST be bonded by 8/31/24.
- 4. District 990 and all Auxiliaries 990s must be filed by 11/15/24. Copy MUST be sent to the Department Treasurer.
- 5. District and Auxiliary Officers' dues must be paid by 12/31/24.
- 6. All Auxiliary official visits must be completed by 12/31/24 unless approved by the Department President.

### PROGRAM GOALS Historian Duties – Media Relations

An Auxiliary Historian is like the person in your home who takes photos and stores them in scrapbooks and albums, giving you the opportunity to reflect on changes over time. Your family member keeps family awards to show accomplishments. They buy and save souvenirs as memories of family events and vacations. They are the memory keeper, the collector of the family history. They are the Family Historian.

The Auxiliary Historian is the memory keeper and collector of the Auxiliary history. As a group, we can look back on our history to reflect on how we have changed over time, and review our accomplishments that show us what has worked for the Auxiliary. Our Auxiliary members can look back on the memories of the great things we have done in our communities, promoting patriotism, helping our veteran's families at the National Home, hospital visits, working with legislators, scholarships, working with our youth and most of all everything we do for our veterans, which is the reason we do what we do.

The Media Relations side of this is to let the public out in our communities more aware of what we do, the lives we change and the veterans we serve. Media is communication. There are a lot of Media platforms. You may not be able to use them all, but the more you use the more you are able to promote and educate the public about the goals of our programs and our accomplishments. You may even entice them to join you.
