

#### Who Is (and how are you) Eligible to live at the National Home:

Believe it or not it is common that many are not clear as who and what makes you Eligible to live at the National Home. There are *three lanes of eligibility* through which a family can apply to live at the National Home.

Eligibility stems from the children in the family. They are listed in one of three ways:

- 1) A veteran family with at least one parent that has served and been honorably discharged.
- 2) An active duty military family with a parent currently serving in the armed forces or reserves
- 3) A family that is related to a VFW or VFW Auxiliary member, including grandparents or step parents.

The *third lane* is the most wide-reaching, as many people living in the US have a parent or grandparent who has served. Sometimes the child's parent or grandparent is not a VFW member but eligible to become one. If they become a member then the family is eligible to apply to live at the National Home. Many realize they are eligible through our Helpline 1-800-313-4200 - Helpline staff will help callers determine eligibility.

This is why it's so important we have the Helpline phone number in our cell phones, if you haven't put it in your cell phone do so today and then report it! Thank you, to those Auxiliaries that have.
